



## GEOGRAPHICAL FEATURES

Gujo city is located right at the central part of Gifu prefecture that is also in the middle of the country. It adjoins Gero city in the east, Takayama city in the north, Seki city and Ono city of Fukui prefecture in the west, and Mino and Seki cities in the south.

The city is surrounded by the grandeur of the nature in geographical terms.

It's altitude ranges from 110m above the sea level at Konno in Minami-cho to the highest of 1,810m, Mt Choshigamine in Shirotori district.

It has highland areas in Hirugano-kogen and Uwano-Kogen at the foot of Mt Dainichi in Takasu district, where the upstream of River Nagara takes its origin, as well as another highland of Meiho-Kogen around Mizore area of Meiho.

Twenty four Class One rivers run through the city territory, such as Rivers of Nagara, Wara, Itoshiro and others.

The city has a rich and clean water resources supported by headwater protections of the forest and mountains in the area.

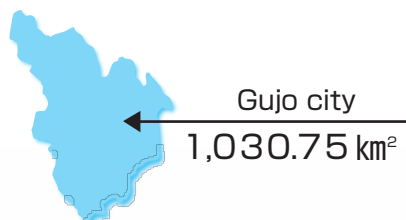
EAST LONGITUDE
